- GROUP ATTACK**
Exercises & games that improve small group play with an emphasis on Fast Break Attacks.
- FINISHING**
Exercises & games that improve techniques & encourage instinctive play around the goal.
- SPEED:**
Exercises & games that agility, acceleration & power with & without the ball.
- MOVES 1v1**
Exercises & games that teach game winning individual moves & create space against packed defenses.
- PASSING & RECEIVING**
Exercises & games that improve 1st touch, so important at all levels, & to encourage accurate & creative passing.
- BALL MASTERY**
Repetition ball control exercises with both feet, one player & one ball.

- Will include graduated skills building in the following areas:
- **Basic Saves** — ensures that goalies can make the straightforward plays, every time
 - **Dropping & Diving** — good technique will breed confidence & enthusiasm
 - **Distribution with hand & foot** — the goalie is also the first line of attack
 - **Taking High Balls & Handling Crosses** — timing & footwork
 - **Charging & Blocking** — combining bravery with safety
 - **Footwork** — vital to achieve the correct positioning/angles
 - **Communications** — playing big & organizing the defense
